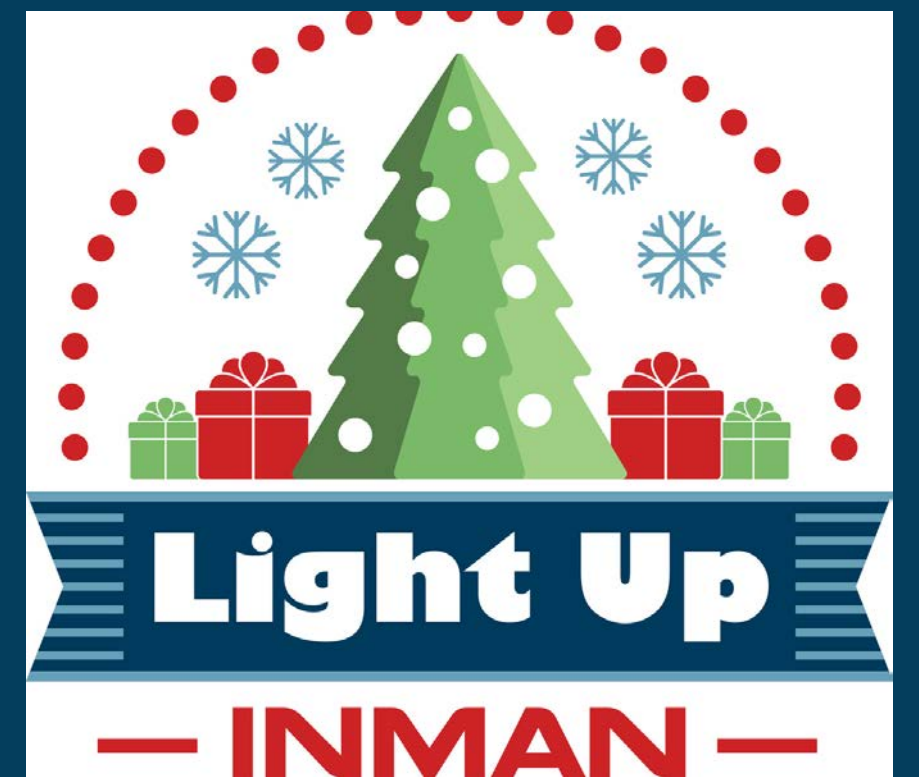

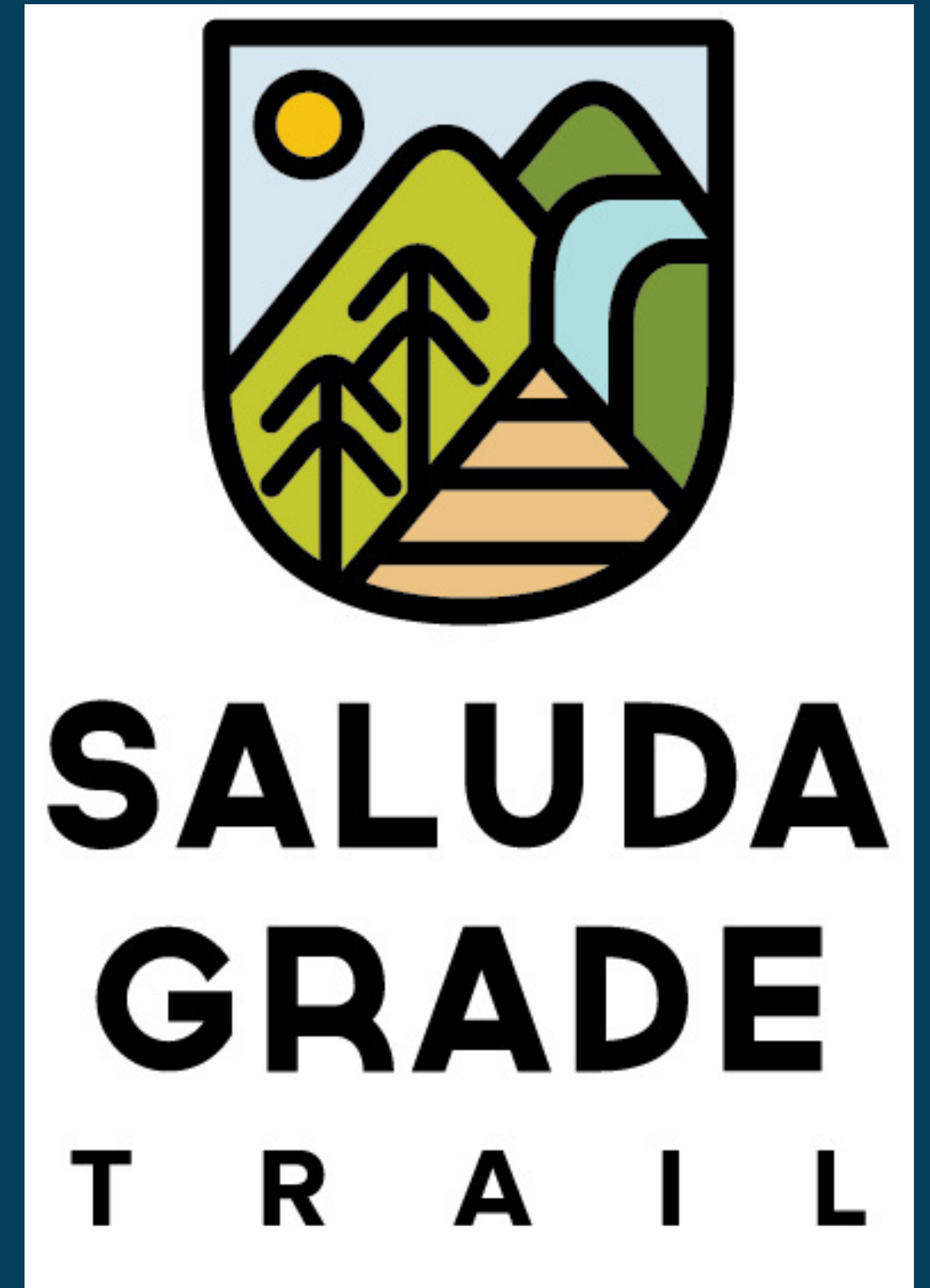


Special Events

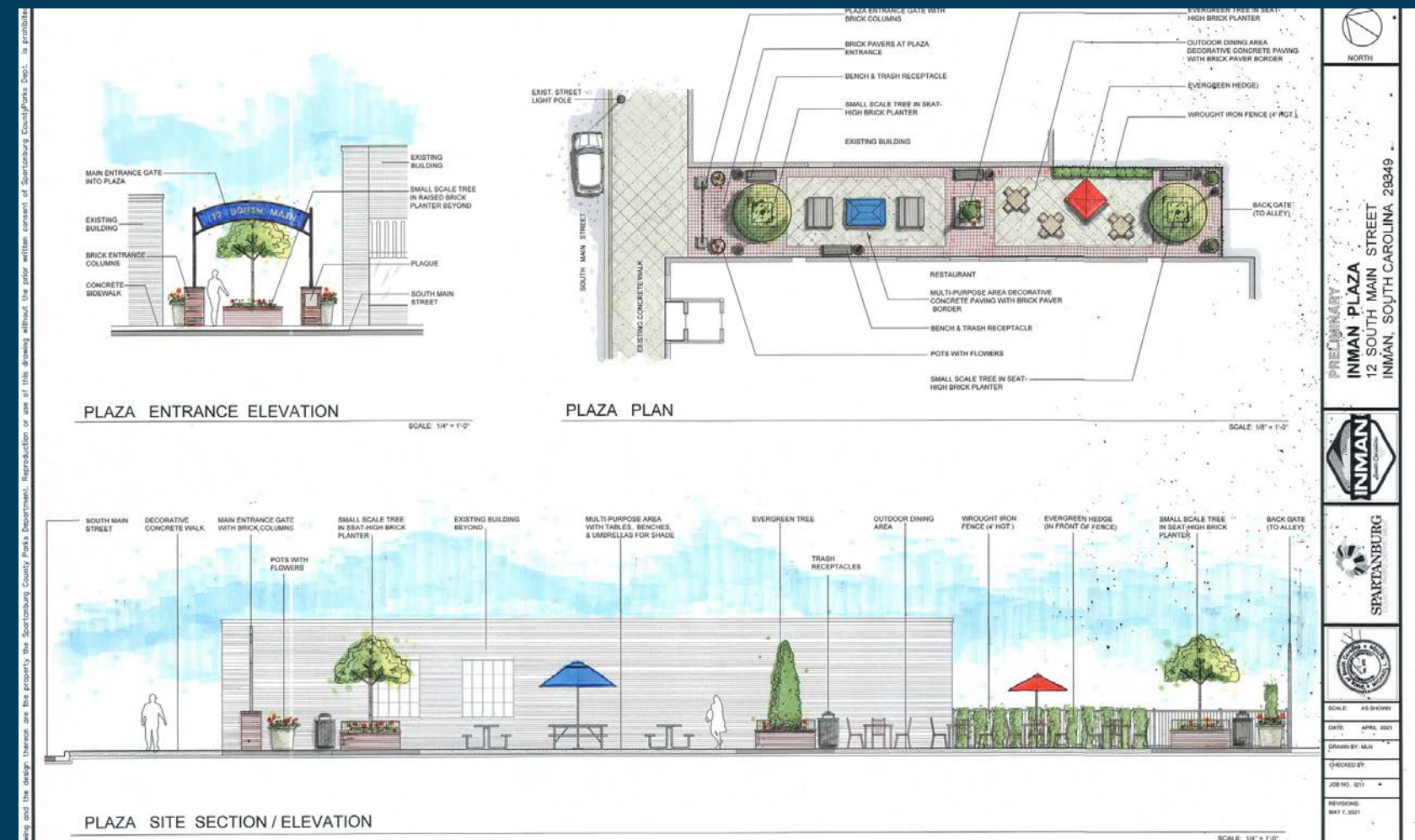
